QUALITY ASSURANCE INDICATORS

- 2.1.1 Space is organized to allow children independence in appropriate ways, and ensure that Carers rarely need to say "no"
- 2.1.2 Effective supervision is a primary consideration when planning play environments
- 2.1.3 Lighting, heating, cooling and ventilation are appropriate
- 2.1.4 Outdoor activities are planned to make use of available shade and to minimize the children's exposure to the effects of the sun
