QUALITY ASSURANCE INDICATORS

- 3.7.11 Experiences for children include an integrated approach to creativity that links various aspects of a day's activities
- 3.7.13 Carers and coordination unit staff recognize and value each child's creativity and plan to enhance it in many aspects of the program
- 3.7.14 Carers and coordination unit staff respect children's creative processes and document them carefully. For example, photographs of temporary creations such as block construction are displayed; recordings of singing and music created by children are shared with families.
- 4.1.6 Toys, equipment and play materials are safe for the ability levels of the children using them and are made available to children only in areas where they may be used safely. For example, ride-on toys such as bikes, trikes, skates and skateboards are used only in safe areas
